

Collective Investments Disclosure

The portfolios were previously managed by Sanlam Collective Investments, prior to 28 August, 2023.

Collective investment schemes are generally medium- to long-term investments. Performance is calculated for the portfolio and the individual investor performance may differ as a result of initial fees, actual investment date, date of reinvestment and dividend withholding tax. Lump sum investment performances are being quoted.

A fund of funds is a portfolio that invests in portfolios of collective investment schemes that levy their own charges, which could result in a higher fee structure for the fund of funds.
