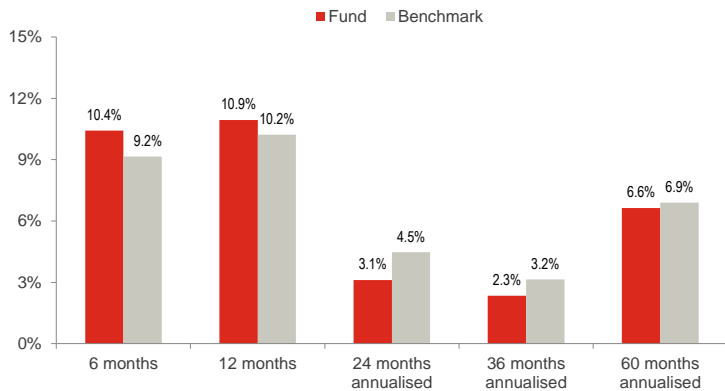

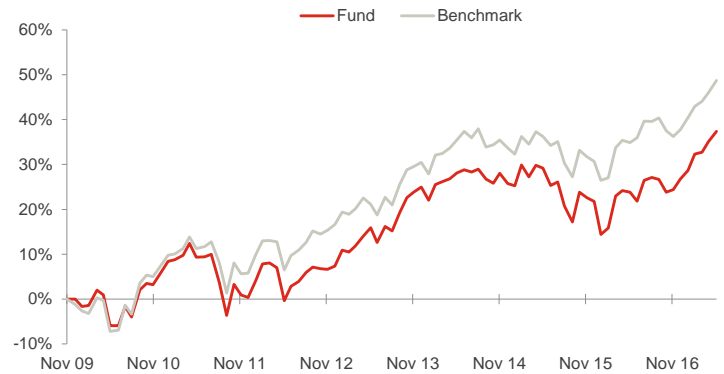
## Investment objective

The Fund focuses primarily on long-term capital growth over the full investment cycle through a relatively high exposure to international growth assets. The portfolio will retain a good level of diversification, however, and will invest in a wide range of asset classes including cash, bonds, equities and property. The Fund is ideally suited to investors with an investment horizon of 5 years or longer and an intermediate (between moderate and high) risk tolerance.

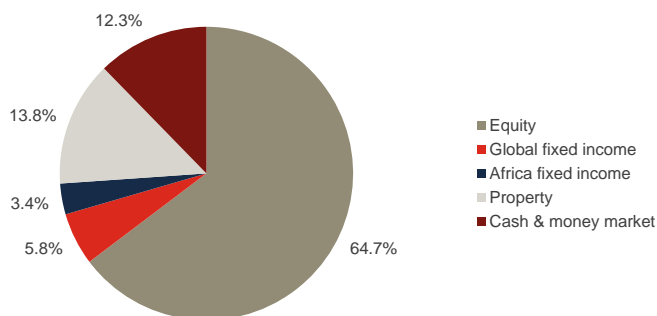

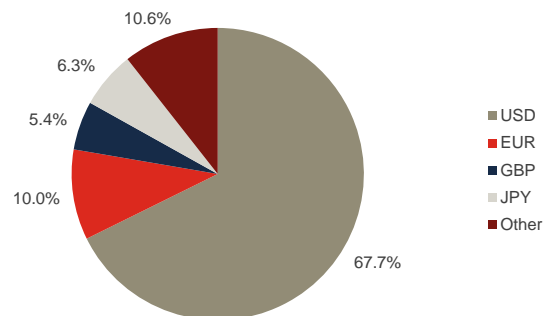

## ■ Market commentary

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Global equity markets put in another strong month, driven by the outcome of the French elections with Emmanuel Macron prevailing over populist candidate Marine Le Pen. The MSCI AC World index gained 2.21% in US dollar terms. Emerging markets outperformed developed markets gaining 2.96% and 2.12% respectively. Global bonds ended the month positive 1.52%.

The US economy grew at a slower pace than initially set in the final quarter of 2016. The main reason for the slow down came from slower growth in government spending and investment. The market is currently assigning a 90% probability that the US Federal Reserve will raise official interest rates by 0.25% when they meet in June. Unemployment eased to 4.50% due to faster job creation.

The UK also grew at a softer pace of 0.20% in the first quarter. This was due to slower growth in household spending.

The market is expecting the European Central Bank ("ECB") to start reducing the size of its asset purchases soon.

Most emerging markets performed better in the first quarter.

Global inflation remains benign and the risk of deflation appears to be fading in most countries. US inflation is standing at 2.0% whereas inflation in the Eurozone increased to 1.90%, while UK inflation accelerated to 2.70%. The risk of deflation remains highest in Japan where inflation remains low at only 0.40%.

We remain concerned with market valuations and risk, however structurally we need to retain growth assets in the portfolio to ensure we achieve our longer term objectives. Asset allocation and diversification therefore remain key to ensuring downside risk management while continuing to achieve required returns. We continue to focus our attention on consistently applying our philosophy and process to ensure we meet our investment objectives over the long term. We need to urge investors to remain patient and committed to their chosen investment strategy as negative surprises are possible.
